# Coach Training Program



## INTRODUCTION

The INUMC Coach Training Program is for individuals who have a heart for serving God's transforming of the world through coaching. The INUMC believes that coaching is a ministry that can have a tremendous impact by helping people realize their potential as children of God and achieve God's dreams for their lives.

The INUMC Coach Training Program is open to United Methodist Deacons, Elders, Associate Members, Local Pastors and lay members of the INUMC (lay members must be able to demonstrate two years of membership in an INUMC congregation).

The Program provides professional coach training to INUMC clergy and lay members that will prepare them for certification by the International Coaching Federation.



## APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Prepare a personal statement (400 to 600 words) describing your understanding of coaching and your interest and goals in completing coach training.
2. Complete the Application (personal statement is submitted as part of online application).
3. Complete phone interview (approx. 30 minutes).
4. Receive admissions decision after interview
5. Begin training.

## COACH-TRAINEE ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

### Training

Training is provided by Coach Training for Leaders (CTL), [www.empowercoaches.com](http://www.empowercoaches.com).

Coach-trainees must complete 70 hours of training (three modules and 10 hours of mentor coaching), pass any assessments, tests, or evaluations conducted as part of the training, and participate in any post-training supervision provided by the INUMC in order to be considered for certification.

The INUMC anticipates that coach-trainees will work to become professional coaches certified by the International Coaching Federation. Certification requires at least 100 hours of coaching in addition to the training and mentor coaching. For more information, please visit <https://coachfederation.org/>.
